Frequently Asked Questions

How will campers travel on trips?

Campers and Counselors will travel on church van, camp bus, personal vehicles operated by staff parents chaperoning as volunteers.

What preparations does Camp Holiday make for campers safety and medical needs?

A medical facility is 10 minutes away. Camp Holiday is not allowed to administer medications to campers. Lifeguards are on duty when campers attend swimming. Camp Holiday provides supervision at all times. **No camper is ever alone.**

What do campers need for camp?

Our younger camper's ages 5& 6 will have rest time and need to bring a sleeping bag/ sheet and pillow to rest on. Camper's ages 7-12 will need to bring a book/magazine to read during quiet time daily. Please make sure your campers bring swim items weekly (towels, sun block, lotion, extra undergarments). All campers must have a reading and math workbook by the first day of camp.

What should a camper **NOT** bring to camp?

Campers should not bring fireworks, radio, CDs, mp3 players, electronic games, **cell phones**, gum, candy, or money. Any item that could be used as a weapon is prohibited. Money and toys are only allowed when Camp Holiday has free day or field trips.

*If a camper brings a cell phone to camp it will be checked in the morning and given back at the end of the day. In the event of an emergency, the parents will be contacted through our main office.

What are the procedures about visiting and contacting Camp Holiday office?

Parents are always welcomed at Camp Holiday. We encourage visits and participation from all of our parents. A faculty member will make necessary phone calls when needed. Parents may call 301-449-5850 or 301-806-6262 to contact the Camp Director Pastor Lady Kim Allen.

What are the procedures for disciplinary action for a camper who receives more than three warnings about behavior?

Each camper receives three warnings about behavior and the 4th warning the camper **will not** participate on the field trip for the week. Over bearing campers **will not** be tolerated and will be suspended from Camp Holiday up to (3) days. The amount of days is at the discretion of the Camp Director.
